Open from 8:20am - 2:35pm, Sacred Heart School has an enrollment of approximately 146 students with class sizes that permit individual attention.

Sacred Heart is a Christ Centered School which provides Daily Religious Instruction, Seasonal Liturgical Celebrations and Sacramental Preparation by the Parish Priest.

Activities include Instrumental/Band Program, Student Yearbook, School Dances, After School Intramurals, Service Projects, Feinstein Program, and Field Trips.
