Dear Sacred Heart School Families,

It's a privilege to have your children as students in our school community. This has been a year of challenge and opportunity, but some significant realities have remained constant:

- Our average class size is 15, allowing individualized instruction and enrichment for each student.
- Our teachers are exceptional professionals who maintain rigorous academic and moral standards for our students.
- Our tuition for the coming academic year will be \$4,000 for parish communicants and \$4,500 for non-parishioners. Even with this increase to cover necessary improvements, ours is nearly \$1,800 less than the average annual Catholic elementary/middle school tuition in the diocese.
- Significant improvements will be implemented next year: a new online grading/attendance keeping/and reporting software (AminPlus) will allow parents and students to monitor grades, assignments, progress reports and will provide many additional benefits; students will have opportunities to participate in coed sports programs in addition to our two boys basketball teams; new extra-curricular activities besides student council, recycling club, yearbook, band, chorus, and cheerleading will be available. There will also be curricular improvements along with the anticipated hiring of a resource teacher.

As parents with children in our school, you know that Sacred Heart is a gem, an extended family where our young scholars flourish socially, intellectually and spiritually. I encourage you to spread the good news about Sacred Heart School to other parents you know whose children would benefit by joining our school community.

We are now entering the period of student enrollment for the 2019-2020 school year, and I look forward to welcoming back our current K through 7 students.

To re-enroll your child, please complete the forms on this site and return them with the enrollment fee. Signatures of all persons with custodial rights are required on these forms.

Priority enrollment for current students ends on March 15. Open enrollment will follow immediately thereafter. If you do not re-enroll your child during the priority enrollment period, it's possible that he/she might have to be placed on a waiting list.
