As we begin the re-enrollment process for the 2018-2019 school year, I hope you share my opinion that this has been an outstanding year for the students of Sacred Heart School. In the face of depressed economic conditions and a popular culture that is too often anti-Christian, our enrollment has remained relatively stable for the last 10 years. I believe this reflects the importance our community places on a distinctively Catholic Education as a means to achieve success in the face of a more competitive and secular society.

For your assistance in the re-enrollment process, I have included all of the necessary documents in this packet for you to complete. Additional copies of this re-enrollment packet are available online on the "Application for Admissions" page of our school website. In order to re-enroll your child, this packet must be completed and returned with the enrollment fee before admission for the next school year may be finalized. Please note that signatures from all parties with custodial rights are required on these forms.

Priority enrollment is limited to the month of January after which Sacred Heart School enters a period of open enrollment. Failure to re-enroll your child during the month of January could result in his/her name being placed on a waiting list or forfeiting their seat to another student. As openings become available, the following hierarchy will be used to accept students.

1. Children of faculty and staff
2. Members of Sacred Heart Church
3. Members of other Catholic Parishes
4. Non-Catholic students

Please keep us in your prayers as we move through this very important enrollment period. We pray that God will continue to bless SHS as we interview prospective families and make enrollment decisions for next year.
